
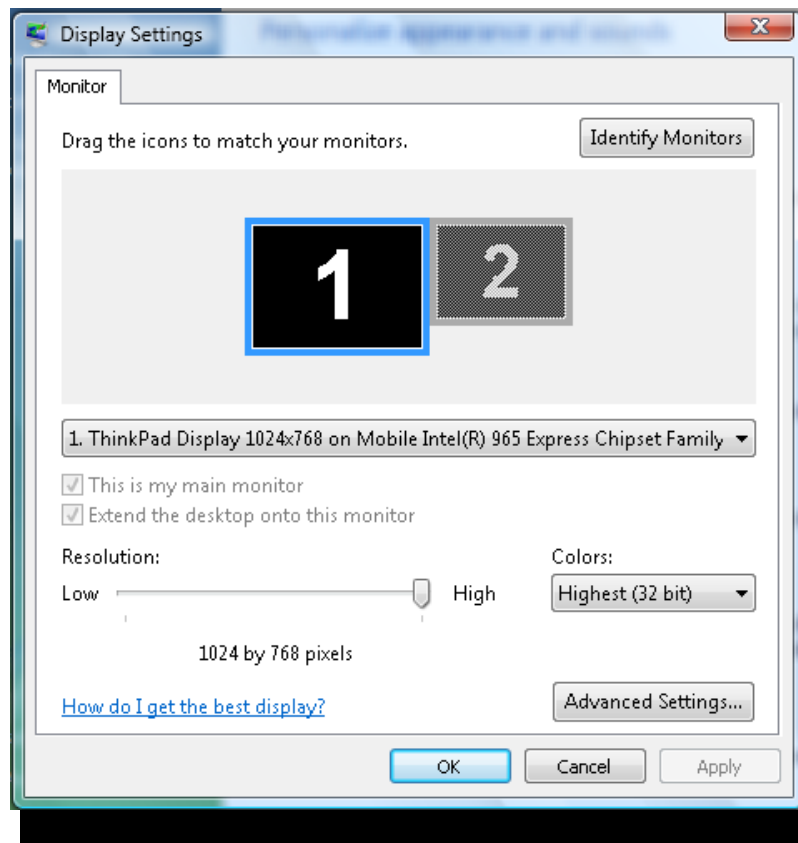




CHANGING YOUR COMPUTER'S SCREEN RESOLUTION

Windows Vista

- Open Display Settings by clicking the Start button , clicking Control Panel, clicking Appearance and Personalization, clicking Personalization, and then clicking Display Settings.
- Under Resolution, move the slider to the resolution you want, and then click Apply.



Windows XP

- First right-click on the [desktop](#) and then left click on **Properties** from the menu that appears.
- The **display properties** dialogue box will appear as shown in **fig 1.1** below, click on the **settings tab** at the top right of the box.
- **Screen Resolution** - This slide bar is what you use to change the resolution, the options you have will depend on your graphics card and monitor. Drag the slider to 1024x768 or higher.

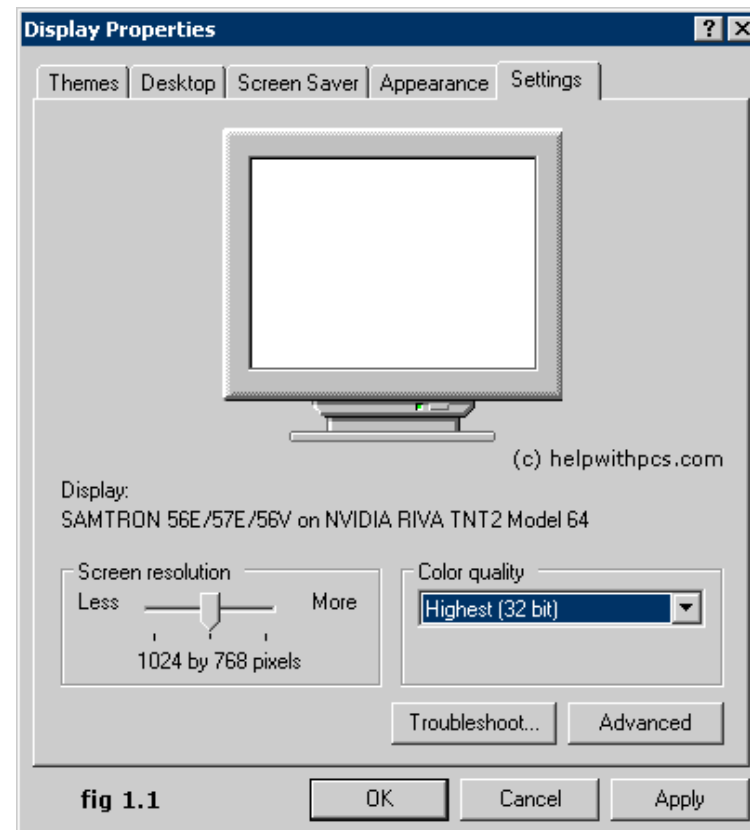
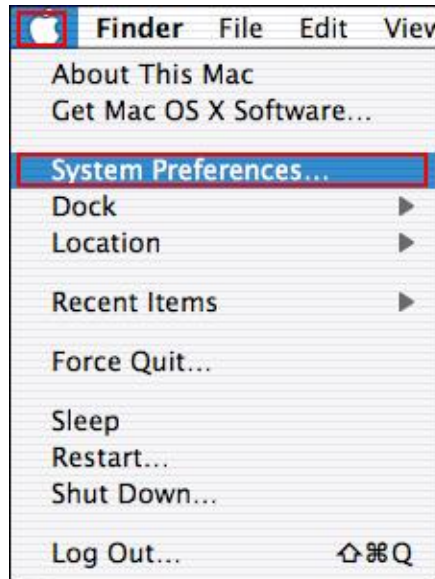

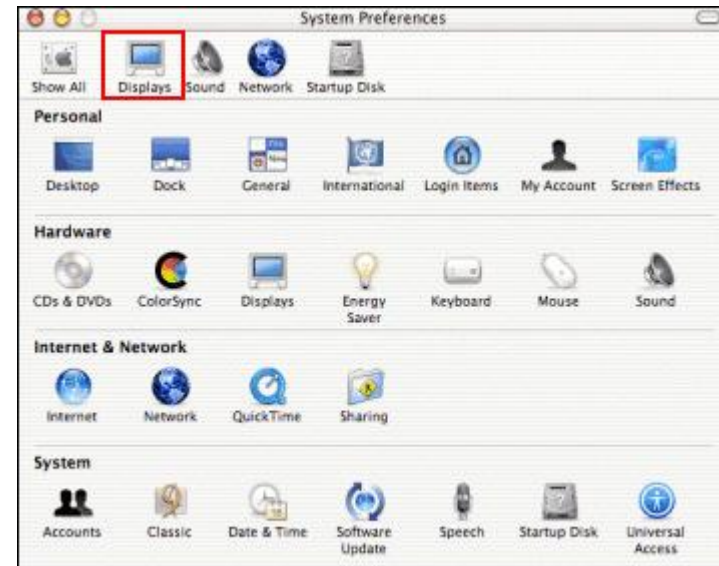
Mac

Steps to set the screen resolution in Mac system are as follows:

- Click on **Apple** icon, select **System Preferences...** as shown in the figure.



- Displays **System Preferences** window. Select **Displays**.



- Select **Displays** tab and set resolution to 1024 * 768
